Safety OORS:

We use the Citywide Expectations of Behaviors Guide

Summer- 3 infractions

28 infractions since school started

Teacher Removal- Child is removed from the classroom for either a period, half day, full day etc. We had two of these in September. Should be 5 days at most. If we reach 10 and it's a student with disabilities it triggers an investigation.

For next month- see if we are able to break it down by grade level

Compare to last year to see if we reduced (CEP Goal)

PBIS- a schoolwide program to reward students for excellent behavior. Set school wide behavior expectations. Ms. M. Lee is an adjunct professor and is teaching us about behavior management.

TCIS- Therapeutic Crisis Intervention in Schools- 2 teachers and Ms. Rodriguez. They are attending 3 sessions to get trained in how to identify triggers and help a child come down when they are in crisis. We would like to send more paras and teachers to get trained.

Autism resources were sent out to teachers to provide parents with. Ms. Garcia translated into Spanish. Ms. Rodriguez can reach out to the district to see if it can be translated into more languages.

We have Harmony, SAPIS, Brainpower, Habits of Mind, PBIS to all work towards lowering infractions.

Title I PAC/CEP:

We looked at Iready data. The beginning of year view looks accurate for the tier placement vs standard view, which doesn't match what is happening in our school.

Math on Iready they can only go one grade level above so we tend to do better.

K, 1, 2 ELA: Acadience: Scaffolded from K-2, each skill builds on previous skills. 1:1 testing with their teacher. Kindergarten looks great, grade 1 is struggling beginning of year, 2nd grade looks great

Amira- Students K-5 have access to this program from HMH. She is an AI person that reads with the children online. It is aligned to the science of reading. We have Amira winners each week. It also has data points to share with parents on how they're reading. The program adapts to the level the children are at. We also purchased Waggle- this replaces Raz Kids.

Xtra Math: We have this as a supplemental activity for children at home. This program can also provide children with certificates for completing work.

Construction- Nothing happening any time soon

Participatory Funding- Mrs. Curry requested technology.

Michael contacted someone from ResoA and they will be getting back to us

Clubs are starting. No debate teacher to have a debate team.

Maybe we can do a fundraiser/walk/parade to share what we like about school- different colors of flowers to show what you like ex. Yellow is "I like the teachers", red "I love physical education"- Maybe Kindness Club can start this
